What is Medicaid?

Medicaid is health insurance that will pay for your medical care.

- Laboratory services
- Wellness and preventative care

Who can get Medicaid?

If you are a U.S. citizen or legal resident for 5 years, and your family's income is less than the amounts below, you likely qualify for Medicaid:



1 family member

Less than \$16,394 per year or \$1,367 per month



2 family members

Less than \$21,108 per year or \$1,843 per month



3 family members

Less than \$27,821 per year or \$2,319 per month



4 family members

Less than \$33,534 per year or \$2,795 per month
